









Review meeting

The E³UDRES² Ent-r-e-novators project has reached a commendable milestone following its comprehensive evaluation by the European Commission. Covering the first 15 months of its operation, the review meeting held on March 22nd has concluded with results that signify the project's excellent progress and its strict adherence to the Grant Agreement.

The meeting, a convergence of the Project Officer, the Commission's appointed Reviewer, the Project Coordinator, all work package leaders, and representatives from the partner institutions, marked the culmination of the evaluation process.
